



CONFERENCE TRIP TO BALATON UPLANDS AND THE LAKE

After the roundtable discussion a bus is waiting and takes the group into the Balaton Uplands. The unique values of the landscape are the gently sloping hillsides, wide mountaintops and basins, flat highlands with spotted karstic elements.

Lunch in a tiny village.

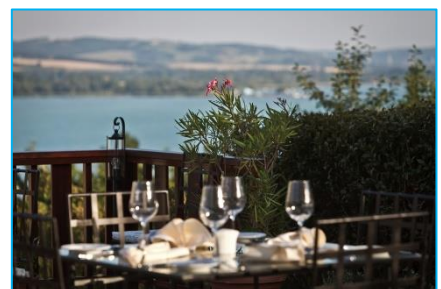
The trip continues to the Tihany Peninsula, which is one of the sacred places of Hungary – and has geological values as well. First the group has a guided visit to the Tihany Abbey, a Benedictine monastery established in 1055.

To discover the most famous plant of the Peninsula, the group visits the Lavender House.

Next to the Lavender House there is the Inner Lake, which is surrounded by geyser cones thanks to the previous volcanic activities in the area. The most remarkable of these is the Golden House geyser cone – the group walks up to this cone to enjoy the view.

Short stop in Balatonfüred at the Tagore Promenade.

Dinner combined with wine tasting.
